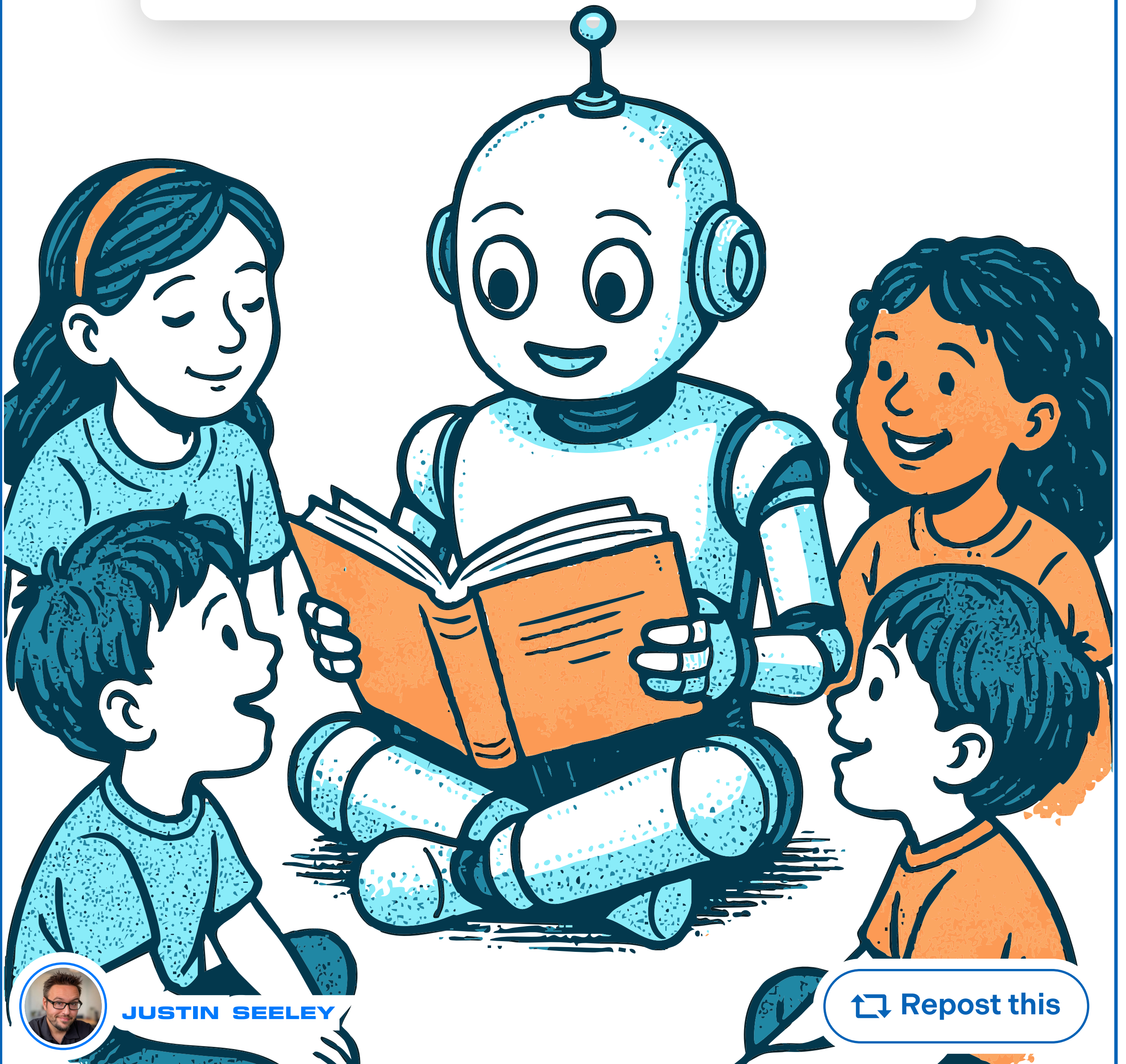

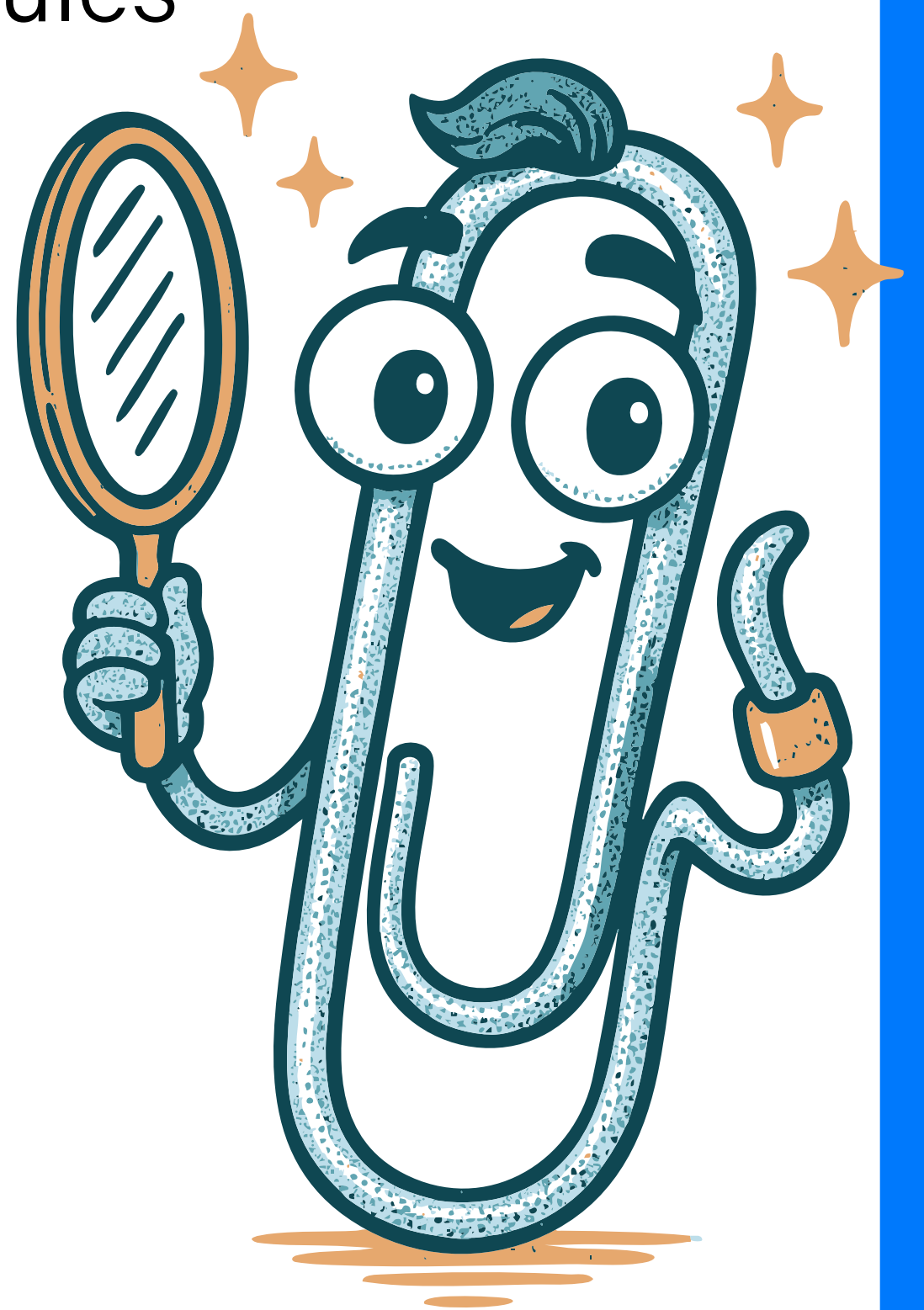
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What is Agentic AI?

It's an AI that doesn't just respond — it takes initiative.



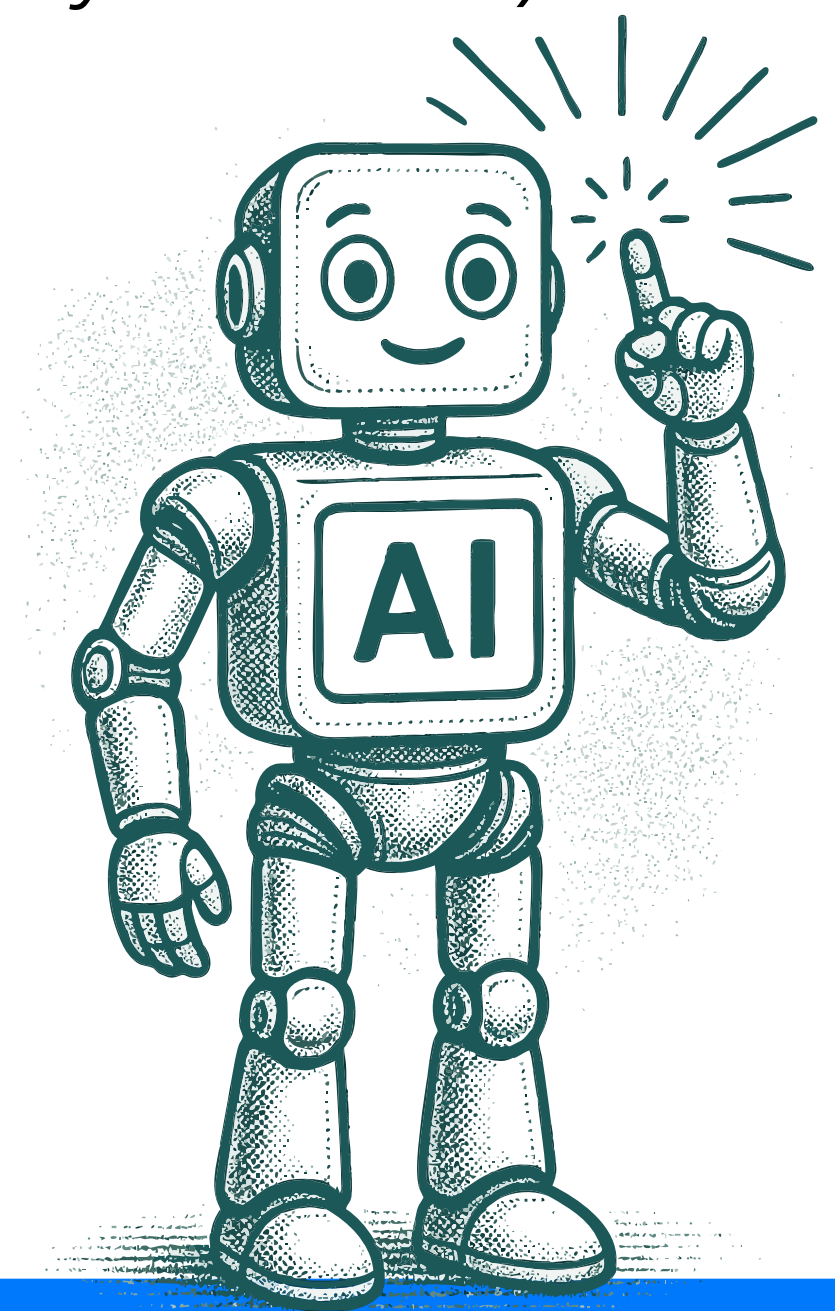
Agentic = AI + Autonomy

Long answer?

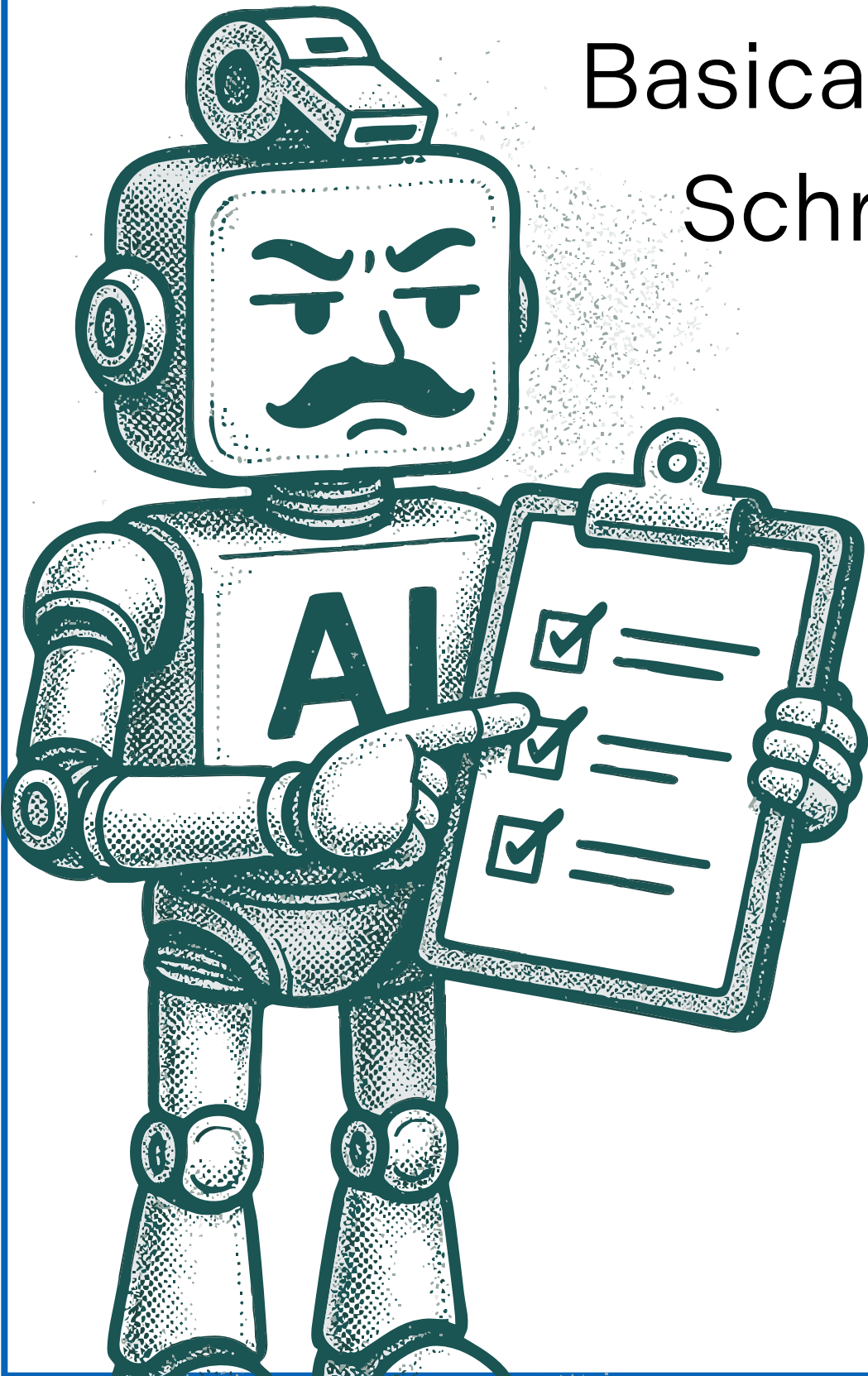
Here are 6 types of Agentic AIs and how they can make your life easier...

They'll chat with your customers at 2AM.

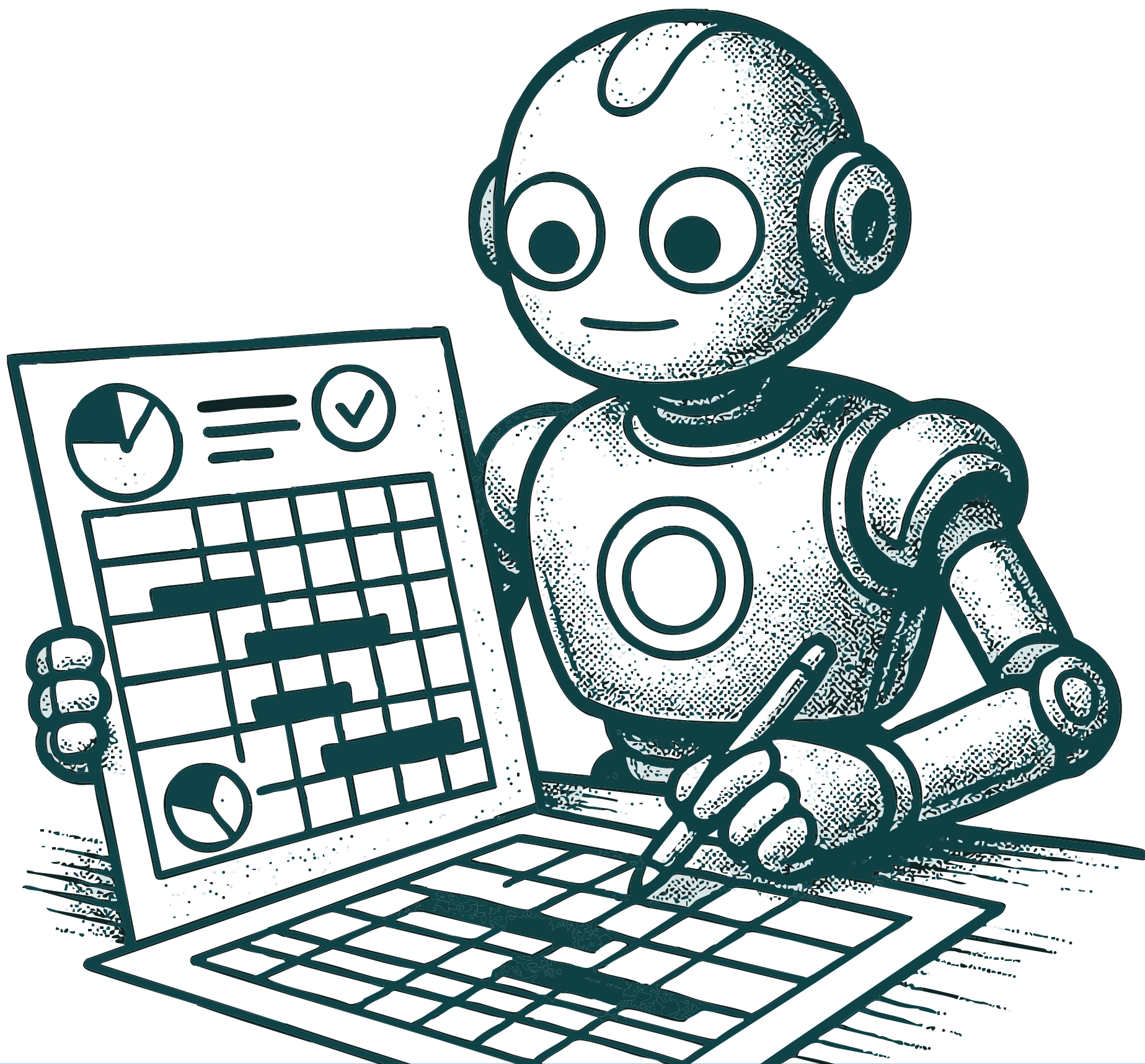
- FAQs

They organize chaos.

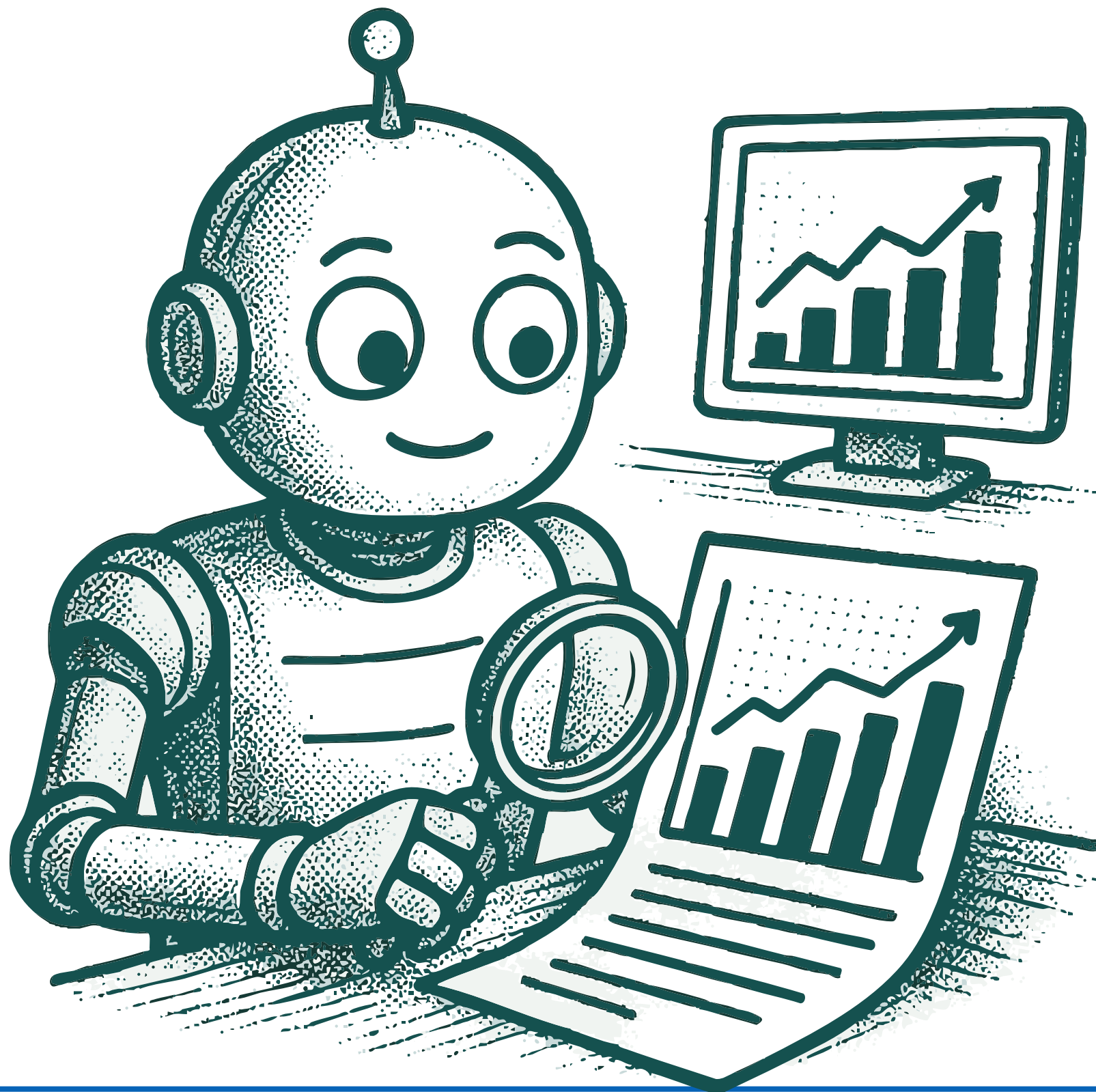
- Break down big projects

Spoiler: You'll want more.

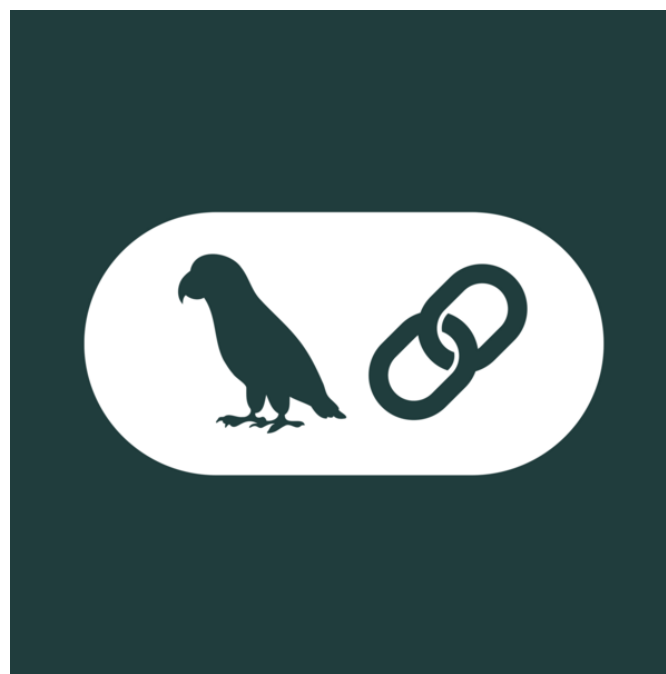

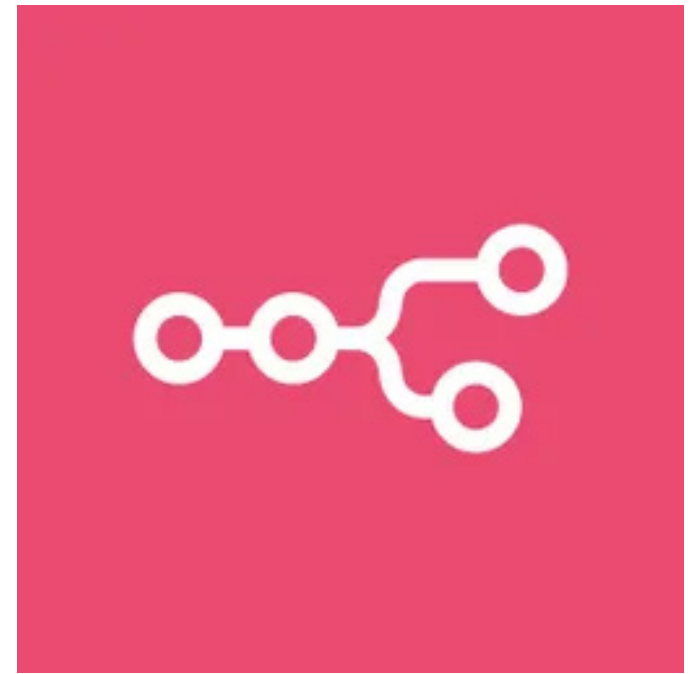
